

4 Conclusion

- 4.1.1 In Stage 4 PE, a series of PE activities were held to collect and solicit comments and concerns from the public and relevant stakeholders. In general, majority of the stakeholders of the community were in favour of the Project and their support and understanding have been further fostered through the PE activities.
- 4.1.2 Various topics, such as the result of the EIA, proposed temporary traffic arrangement, proposed mitigation measures, and tentative construction programme were discussed to further address the concerns from the public and relevant stakeholders identified in the previous PE activities.
- 4.1.3 Some new concerns and comments were identified in Stage 4 PE. Relevant stakeholders in the vicinity of the project sites raised concerns and queries related to the construction of the Project, such as potential health impact on the patients in A Kung Kok Shan Road, operation safety of the site explosive magazine, effect of blasting on the nearby structures, and the traffic impact on the public transport system.
- 4.1.4 With respect to the concerns and queries raised in Stage 4 PE, some anticipated construction impacts were demonstrated to the stakeholders through models and measuring equipment. Moreover, additional mitigation measures were put into the contract requirements to address the concerns of the relevant stakeholders.
- 4.1.5 The concerns and queries solicited in Stage 4 PE provided information for the implementation of suitable mitigation measures to alleviate the construction impacts to the vicinity. Moreover, the opinions collected would serve as an important basis for formulating the detailed design of the Project and contract requirements. In conclusion, a better project delivery has been achieved by further fulfilling public's needs through the Stage 4 PE.
- 4.1.6 With the formation of Community Liaison Groups, direct and effective communication channel between the project team and the community was set up, information on progress and construction arrangement will be disseminated through regular CLG meetings.
